Try as many activities as you like.

Community	Dress up as a character from one of our books and help to do some chores at home and send in a photo of you doing it.	Say something nice about your friend to make them smile and feel happy.	Can you read to a brother, sister or friend? Share your favourite stories or poems.
Literacy	Learn a classic poem or song to share with the class.	Choose a subject that you like and prepare a presentation to give to the class. You can bring in or make things to help you.	Talk to an older member of your family or friend about their favourite story when they were a child. Add this to the display in our classroom.
Numeracy	Learn to count forwards and backwards to 100. Can you do it? Come and show the class.	Make an illustration from your class book using 2D shapes. Try to label them too.	Learn the pairs of numbers that make ten. Take a photo or make a poster to show us how you did this.
Physical	Challenge yourself to learn a new skill. It could be skipping, riding a bike, juggling? Then come in and show us or take a photo.	Count how many hops or jumps you can do in 1 minute every day for a week. Try and beat your last score each time.	Compose a rhythm using your body or household objects. Film it or come in and perform it for us.
Creativity	Take a stroll through the Gruffalo's wood and collect things to make an autumn collage.	Design and make your own Swallow's or Amazon's boat.	Design and make an ensign for Captain Hook's pirate ship.
Topic	Make a Gruffalo Crumble at home and share the recipe with the class.	Read some classic books with your family. Who is your favourite character?	Design a treasure map with labels.

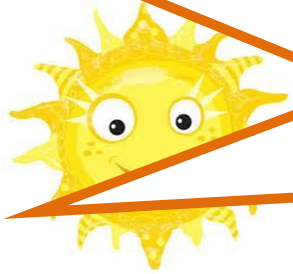


Colour in the rectangle on the grid once you complete the activity.
