Welcome to our Spring Term topic, 'Let There Be Light!'



This term is another busy term with our topic being 'Let There Be Light' where the children will have the opportunity to explore light. We have already begun to identify light sources and have set the children the task of finding different light sources at home. It is the perfect opportunity for us to learn about electricity, making simple circuits and exploring the history of the light bulb. We hope to design and make some great light houses and use our knowledge of circuits to create a working model. How exciting! Alongside this well will look at the Islands coastline and the importance of the light houses and where they are position. We will look at how light affect materials and carry out some simple experiments too.

We are currently in the process of setting the date for 'Our Golden Tickets Experience' from Father Christmas where we will be learning a variety of different skills through our drama workshop. We just can't wait! In PE we will be learning and developing our strength and coordination through throwing and catching, continuing to improve our ball skills and creating our own carnival dance. Our P.E. sessions are often outside so please ensure that your child has a warm P.E. kit and suitable footwear in school each week.

Our current homework grid is related to our topic. Please encourage your child to complete the tasks with the family as well as continuing reading and times tables practise. There will be lots of rewards for completed homeworks.

Please continue to hear your children read daily, practise their counting, times tables and number bonds. SATs will take place throughout May and we will be holding a SATs information session for parents soon so look out for this date.
