The Christmas Tree arrives on Wednesday 7th December and this year we are creating decorations based on children's characters from the BBC with a Christmassy touch. We are also taking part in the Cowes Methodist Christmas Tree Festival and focusing on difference, diversity and ensuring everyone is welcome for the festive season. The Christmas Tree Festival is taking place on Saturday 10th December at Cowes Methodist Church.

This year we are developing an alternative to our Christmas Advent Calendar and hope that you will love this idea just as much!

Raffle Tickets: Yet again, the team have secured lots of lovely prizes for this year's raffle. The school raffle form has already gone out and this will close on Monday 12th December. Christmas Cards: We have for a few years decided not to have Christmas cards in school. Each year group will decide on a charitable organisation to raise funds for and class teachers will let you know these as we head towards Christmas.

Reception Nativity will take place at 4pm on Thursday 15th December. The children will remain at school to get ready for their performance. All families are welcome to join the Nativity Performance (however, Reception families will of course be given priority).
