Mrs Brailsford will then cover Miss Squibb and Miss Fuller and support curriculum cover for the remaining afternoons.

Transition Days:

Our Transition Days are Monday 3rd July (PM Only), Tuesday 4th July, Wednesday 5th July and Thursday 6th July (AM only).

On the afternoon of Monday 3rd July, we will gather the children in the Hall to introduce the new teachers and they will then go to their new classes with their new teachers. Please pick up from their new classrooms set out on the following page. For the following three mornings they will arrive in their new classrooms and leave from these too. On the afternoon of Thursday 6th July please collect from your child's current classroom.

Year 7 (current Year 6): 9.00am-3.00pm

Year 7 (current Year 6) will go off to their new schools, but if they are not at their new school they need to arrive through the playground gates and come into the Hall at the back-entrance doors. They will be doing sports activities and completing transition tasks during the transition days.

New Intake Reception Transition Days:

Tuesday 4th July (9am – 11.30am) and (12.30pm – 3pm) Wednesday 5th July – All day – Packed Lunch Needed Thursday 6th July – 9am – 11.30am

We look forward to welcoming all our new intake children on these days.

Each teacher has to have ten percent of their working week for Planning, Preparation and Assessment (PPA). We have organised these times for 30 minutes every day during assembly and the LSAs will then complete class reading, times tables and spellings for fifteen minutes after. This will allow consistency for the children throughout the week. This will take place between 8.45am – 9.15am. Reception will organise their times throughout each day.

Assemblies will also be during this time on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday. Celebration Assembly will take place on a Thursday.

Drop off and Collections:

In September, school will open at 8.20pm for all year groups and end at 2.50pm. We would like everyone in school by 8.35am ready for registration.

A staggered beginning and end of the day will begin with Year R, 2 and 3, followed by Years 1 and 4 and then Years 5 and 6.

Doors open for Years R, 2 and 3 from 8.20am ready for registration at 8.35am and doors open for pick up at 2.40pm. Doors open for Years 1 and 4 from 8.23am ready for registration at 8.35am and doors open for pick up at 2.45pm. Doors open for Years 5 and 6 from 8.25am ready for registration at 8.35am and doors open for pick up at 2.50pm.

Year R, 1 and 2 drop off and pickups: will be to and from classrooms

Year 3 and 4 drop off and pickups: Drop off and main gate and collect from classrooms

Year 5 and 6 drop off and pickups: Drop off at the main gate and children will be brought down to the main gate for collection.

Term Dates:

Our previous consultation was in favour of having our five staff development days immediately after the May half-term every year. These dates have been agreed at the Trustees Meeting and will be **Monday 3rd June 2024 - Friday 7th June 2024.**

Autumn Term 2023 - school opens on Friday 1st September 2023 for all children


