

# **Dance Live 2023** Final Information

**Dear Families** 

We are so excited about Dance Live 2023 in the coming weeks. The show is on Thursday 23<sup>rd</sup> February at Portsmouth Guildhall.

## **Travel**

We are travelling to the venue with the same arrangements as last year via the Wightlink Car Ferry as foot passengers and hope this allows our families to follow the same route too.

We will be getting the 12pm Car Ferry from Fishbourne to Portsmouth and returning on the 10pm Wightlink Car Ferry Portsmouth to Fishbourne.

Children need to be dropped off at Fishbourne Car Ferry Terminal no later than 11.20am where your child will be signed in by your child's group leader.

Children will need to be collected at 10.45pm from the Fishbourne Car Ferry from your child's group leader.

We will text you your child's group leader and number the day before the trip so you know who to drop them off to. This will be your child's leader for the trip and collection too.

We understand this may cause some issues for dropping off your child. If you are stuck for dropping off we may have limited capacity to take children to the ferry port from school. Please ring the office on 293 233 to let us know and we will try our best to help.

If families are watching the show you are more than welcome to book the same return ferry as us and we can hand your child over to you on the boat. Wightlink are offering a 50% discount for families of Dance Live children and we have attached the details of how to claim the discount when booking your travel to this form.

From the car ferry port, we will walk in our groups up to Portsmouth Guildhall and back again for our return.

### Lunch

As this will be a long day your child needs to bring TWO PACKED LUNCHES, drinks and a refillable water bottle (no glass and no nut products please).

### What to Wear

Your child needs to come dressed in black bottoms (trousers/leggings). We will give out their Dance Live T-Shirts before the day which need to be worn with the black bottoms on the day. They need sensible shoes and a warm, waterproof coat too. If your child has longer hair please can your child year their hair up in plaits if possible or a pony tail if plaits cannot be done.

#### **Medicines**

If you child requires any medicines for the trip please ensure these are brought in to school no later than Monday 20<sup>th</sup> February. These needs to be in named boxes/bottles and an Administering Medicines Form will need to be completed alongside them.
