

Dear Families

Firstly, thank you very much to all our families, children and staff for their continued support. We have updated our Autumn plan to share with you.

We will continue handwashing as this remains the most critical element to ensure safety for all. The guidance 'Living with Covid' continues to support that children continue to thoroughly wash their hands and we will continue to do this at all transition points during the day.

We will remain mostly within our year groups with planned mixing across the day. Assemblies will continue in the hall or in children's own classroom via video but we will now allow three year groups in the hall.

All rooms being used are ventilated as much as possible with windows open as per the continued guidance. This just needs to be a flow of air rather than fully open exposure to the elements. Children to wear school hoodies and zoodies for outside play only (this may change when winter comes).

Our enhanced cleaning procedures will remain the same as before.

Covid testing

There is no need for testing.

Face coverings

Are no longer required.

School visitors and families onsite

We encourage families to pre-book appointments in school where possible and also offer a video calls if requested. If you are visiting the main office, you will be asked to sanitise your hands and if you are feeling well whilst we sign you in.

Most meetings can be carried out by video call or face to face, whichever you prefer. Professionals supporting children will be permitted to visit following hygiene procedures. Coaches such as ballet and dance will be in school for year groups.

New Intake Tours can now be pre-booked via the main office and Open Days will return.

We will continue to invite families back into school in for class performances providing that no further restrictions are imposed. Face coverings will not need to be worn for these.



Drop off and pick ups

All children need to be in school for their year group's times and in school no later than 8.35am, ready to start their day.

These are as follows:

Years R, 2 and 3: 8.25am – 2.40pm

Years 1 and 4: 8.30pm - 2.45pm

Years 5 and 6 - 8.35am - 2.50pm

The outside handwashing facilities will be used for the children to use before entering the building.

Office procedures

School remains cashless.

The office will operate one parent in main reception at once.

<u>PE</u>

P.E kits/swimming kits are to be taken home and washed after each use. You will find your child's P.E. day information on your year group Newsletter which will be sent out to you shortly.

Outdoor sports will be prioritised where possible. Families will be allowed to attend sporting events that are outside. Indoor events may take place for particular year groups.

Swimming will continue for Years 1 - 4 as part of their P.E curriculum.



Breakfast/£1 club and after schools clubs/Den

After school - the Den will be open and normal procedures apply.

Breakfast club –is running and will run 7.30am-8.30am. Again, normal procedures apply.

In the morning, the children will be in the hall in bubble areas for their year groups. Front office will sign them in, disinfect hands and take them to the hall where the registers will be taken.

After school, children using the £1 am/pm club will continue to be grouped in their year group bubbles using the area around the hall. Children will be brought down to main front door at the end of the club.

The times for £1 am/pm are as follows:

AM Club - 7.55am – 8.35am

PM Club - 2.40pm - 3.20pm

After school clubs will continue mainly in year groups, both for outside professionals and in school. However, if not in year groups records of children attending must be kept. All bookings need to be made and paid for in advance on School Money.

Attendance for all Children

All children are required to attend school. We continue with all normal policies for attendance, including fines.

Assemblies

Assemblies will be at 8.50am every morning. Year groups from R - 6 will attend in the hall on a rota basis. Three year groups will be in assembly at once but children will remain in year groups. A gap will be left between year groups.
