As part of our Let There Be Light topic and our learning on inventions, Year 3 will be visiting Osborne House in East Cowes on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> February. We will spend the day exploring Queen Victoria's Island home, taking part in a workshop on Victorian inventions and visiting the beach and 'bathing machine'. Children should wear full school uniform for the trip, including a blue slip. We do plan to be outdoors for part of the day, so please ensure your child wears a warm, waterproof coat and comfortable shoes.

We will leave school just before 9:30am to be collected by a Southern Vectis bus, returning to school at around 2:30pm in time for normal pick up. All children will require a packed lunch on this day - please reply to this email to let us know if your child is entitled to free school meals and will require a school packed lunch, indicating whether they would like a cheese, ham or tuna sandwich.

The cost for this trip will be £3 per child, payable through School Money. This contribution is to pay for the cost of travel to Osborne House. You will also be asked to confirm your consent for the trip through School Money.
