Find a picture of a snowy owl and three facts about this type of bird.</p>	<p><u>Numbers</u> Harry Potter is 20 years old. Practice ordering your numbers up to 20 correctly.</p>
<p><u>Speaking and Listening</u> Learn one of the spells from Harry Potter. Can you recite it to the class and tell us what the magic spell does?</p>	<p><u>Physical / Outdoors</u> Go on a scavenger hunt and collect things from outdoors to make your own magical potion.</p>	<p><u>Writing</u> Write a secret message using invisible ink. Instructions on how to make invisible ink are attached.</p>	<p><u>Reading</u> Share a story book about wizards or witches (e.g. Room on the Broom), with your family. Bring in the story to retell to the class.</p>
<p><u>News</u> The Daily Prophet is the newspaper in Harry Potter. Bring in a news article that interests you to or that is related to something magical to fill our own Daily Prophet.</p>	<p><u>The World</u> In Harry Potter, there is a 'Sorting Hat'. Sort a selection of different materials into their groups (e.g. metal, plastic etc.) and ask a grown up to take a photo.</p>	<p><u>Space, Shape and Measure</u> Make Hogwarts school out of junk modelling and list the shapes you have used.</p>	<p><u>Gender Neutral</u> Design a gender neutral uniform for Hogwarts. Think carefully about making sure boys and girls will like it.</p>

HOW TO MAKE INVISIBLE INK

method #1: BAKING SODA

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- MIX EQUAL PARTS BAKING SODA AND WATER IN A SMALL BOWL
 - GET YOURSELF A MAKESHIFT WRITING TOOL *(also can be used for other methods)*
 TOOTHPICK  COTTON SWAB  PAINTBRUSH
 - USING THE MIXTURE, WRITE YOUR MESSAGE ON A WHITE PIECE OF PAPER
 - WAIT FOR THE INK TO DRY
 - HEAT UP THE PAPER USING A LIGHT BULB (MAKE SURE YOU DON'T TOUCH BULB WITH PAPER)
MESSAGE SHOULD SHOW UP IN BROWN!

method #2: CORN STARCH

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- HEAT 2 TBSP. OF CORN STARCH AND 1 TBSP. WATER IN A SMALL PAN AND STIR UNTIL THEY ARE COMPLETELY DISSOLVED
 - ONCE THE INK COOLS, WRITE YOUR SECRET MESSAGE ON A WHITE PIECE OF PAPER
 - WAIT FOR THE PAPER + INK TO COMPLETELY DRY
 - MAKE A SOLUTION 1 PART IODINE: 10 PARTS WATER
 IODINE SOLUTION
 - LOOK UNDER THE WINDOW
BRUSH IODINE SOLUTION OVER PAPER TO REVEAL MESSAGE

method #3: LEMON JUICE

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- SQUEEZE LEMON JUICE INTO A SMALL BOWL
 - WRITE YOUR MESSAGE ON A WHITE PIECE OF PAPER AND WAIT FOR THE PAPER / INK TO DRY
 - VERY CAREFULLY HEAT PAPER OVER STOVE TOP (OR A LIGHT BULB) UNTIL MESSAGE SHOWS UP IN VERY LIGHT BROWN
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- you are THE COOKIES
