



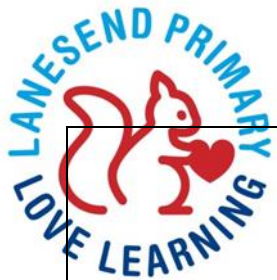
## Pupil Council Minutes 2019-2020
