It continues to be a Governor priority due to the very clear link between attendance and educational attainment; just Google "*the link between attendance and achievement at school*" and there are countless studies and reports. These are not always straightforward to read but they point to a whole variety of negative impacts on a child's life from missing days at school.

Also, it seems here at Lanesend something amazing happens every day, it's such a shame to miss out!

It is also important to remember that classes cannot be repeated for absentees - what is missed, is missed forever.

At the recent FGB, we were informed that attendance this year is down on the same period last year. Consequently, we all agreed to display our attendance performance and targets more prominently across the school. Some schools use a **traffic light system** but in true British style we are going to relate ours to the weather!

Our growing numbers (up 15% on last year) do present challenges, particularly around maintaining the **small learning groups** that ensure every child has an individualised learning experience.
