I thought I would just write regarding the end of term arrangements.

**Reading Books:** Please can all reading books and logs be returned to school by Friday. We will re-sort them over the summer ready for September. **Library Books:** All library books need to be returned by Thursday this week so that our lovely Mrs Arnell can re-organise the library. Please check on bookshelves and try looking under beds at home as we do have to charge for missing library books as they cost a lot of money.

**PE Kits:** Please take these home on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> July, along with all personal bits and pieces you may have at school.

**Lost Property:** A table of lost property will be out by the hall on Monday 18th July after school. Please come and see if your lost bits and bobs are here.

**Monies:** All monies need to be paid by Wednesday 20th July so that we can prepare the accounts for audit.

**Reports** will be sent home from week beginning Monday 18th July, or may be collected on Wednesday 20th July, including results of National Assessments

**Medicines:** All medicines must be collected on Wednesday 20th July. This includes any empty medicine boxes. You must sign to say they have been collected.
