Dear Families

We are getting ever closer to our exciting residential trip to Chateau d'Ebblinghem in France.

Itinerary:

- Please meet at school at **6.50am** on Friday 15th July.
- We will then walk together as one group and depart from the lay-by in Three Gates Road (outside Bookers) at **07.15am**.
- The Fishbourne ferry departs at **8.00am**.
- We will then drive to the Eurotunnel for 1.20pm to arrive at Calais at approximately 3.55pm local time.
- We will be staying at NST's Chateau d'Ebblinghem on the Opal coast for three nights.
- We will return on Monday 18th July and arrive at school at approximately **8.15pm**.

Allocation of rooms: Children will be asked to choose three people with whom they would like to share a room. We can guarantee they will be with at least one of their chosen friends. We will tell them the room allocation upon arrival at Chateau d'Ebblinghem.

Medicines: Please find attached:

- **Form B** 'Parent Consent for Non-Prescribed/Non-Controlled Medication to be Administered Whilst in School Care' We will, with your consent, offer to administer Calpol or Piriton to your child if they become unwell. Please complete Form B to confirm this consent. If you do not consent please still return the form stating /no consent'. **Please complete and return this form to the main office no later than Friday 8th July.**

If you have indicated on your EV3 permission form that your child requires prescription medicine during the France trip you will be given a separate form to complete:

- **Form C** 'Parent Request for Medicine to be Administered in School' This form is to be completed with any details of medication your child requires to be administered during the trip. *Please note: we require one form per medication. If you require any additional forms please collect from the main office.*

Please name all clothing, towels, toiletries etc. A clothing and equipment list is attached. We recommend you write a list of all your child's clothing and equipment that has been packed and put the list in their bag, to help your child pack their bag upon departure from France. Please note we cannot accept any responsibility for any lost items.

No sweets are needed! The school will provide these ☺

Spending money: We suggest an amount of up to **50 Euros**. This needs to be in a named envelope/purse and handed in to the school office by **Thursday 14th July**. We will issue a receipt.

Other information:

Personal stereos, mobile phones, Ipods, Ipads, trading cards etc are NOT allowed. Digital cameras are fine, but it will be the child's responsibility to look after their camera and it must be named. We suggest disposable cameras as a better option.

There will be regular updates on the official Lanesend Primary School Facebook page throughout the trip. If there are any changes to travel plans on the day of return - e.g. traffic delays – we will inform you via text message.

The week preceding the France trip is our Olympic Week. On Thursday 14th July if children would like to miss the afternoon Closing Ceremony they may leave early. Children are welcome to come to school a little later on Tuesday 19th July, if they wish, but we ask that all children are in by 10.30am.
