I was reading over the weekend about **how important it is to get outside** with our children, as it really is so good for both their wellbeing and ours.

This Week

This week, although busy inside school, is quite a quiet week for the children. Years 1 and 2 are off swimming and I caught up with Nicky the swimming instructor, who was very impressed with their enthusiasm and their motivation to have a go. She said she just loved it last week. Year 2 have begun their SATs assessments but shhh... don't tell the children! Year 6 are gearing up for their assessments next week. They have been working extremely hard and it was lovely when Marcia came and told me how much she had improved, how proud she was of herself and that she *can* do it, and that it was easy! I have also had some lovely moments supporting some of the children and I have really enjoyed spending time with them. I am sure they will be brilliant next week. **We will be offering a special breakfast for our Year 6 children** each morning and more information will be sent out from the Year 6 team with arrangements. We will need to use the hall in the morning as we have so many more children this year, so we are going to **move the 8 o'clock club to Mr Thorne's room** just for Monday—Thursday next week. Year 6 then go for a bounce at **Isle Jump** on Friday (next week) to jump for joy! Boing!

Tonight at 6.00pm and tomorrow morning at 8.45am I am holding **family information meetings** following on from our consultation and our plans for next year. Please don't worry if you can't make the meetings, I will send out an email tomorrow with the information.

On Thursday and Friday this week we are **interviewing for an Assistant Head** to join the school. We are looking forward to developing this new role next year so that we can fully support the school in its growth. This does mean that there is **no Celebration Assembly this week**, and I also have to move the Parent Forum meeting from tomorrow as I have a SENCO briefing at Oakfield Primary. There are lots of changes to SEND being consulted upon on the Isle of Wight and several questionnaires have gone out. **I would urge you to complete them** because as you can imagine, with budgets being cut this is going to impact the support for children with SEND.

Last week...

Just a round up on last week in school: we had a super visit and twilight session from Voice 21 on oracy. **Oracy**, or talk, is the children's most valuable learning tool and being able to reason, connect, think, agree and disagree are the children's essential skills for life, so we are concentrating on building them within school. **You can help** by talking, thinking, challenging at home too. I was lucky enough to catch a TV programme the other evening called '**Planet Child**' which was fascinating as they sent a group of four to ten year olds off on their own across London to the London Eye (they were being secretly chaperoned!) It was to see how independent our children are and as a four year old myself, a long time ago, I recall that my Mum walked me to school on my first day and then after that I walked by myself. It highlights just how much communities and expectations have changed. The children absolutely loved it and were so proud of themselves. It is definitely a programme that I am going to try and catch again. As a school we want to grow the children into the best adults they can be with all the skills they need to face an unknown future. We all need to be ready to support our children.

Some of our children had a great time doing '**Outdoor Adventurous Activities**' at Wootton last week, and it was lovely to see the Pupil Council building the **little library**. Year 4 had a super time with the **Time Taxi** visitors as they explored history and built dens. It all looked very exciting. We finished the week with our **RE Day** on Deity and it was good to see so many children learning and developing their ideas.



I have consulted with our **current Year 3** to move from two **classes to three classes** as we **welcome a new teacher, Miss Bailey**, to the school. We are currently moving forward with the idea, to begin just before the end of this half term. I know change is always difficult, but again it is about enabling our children to cope with change by using resilience and strength to take on new adventures.

Finally, **congratulations to the Royal Couple** on the birth of their new baby boy!







Inclusion Conference 12th June 2019 'Building Something Positive' Doctor Wenn B Lawson



Psychologist, lecturer and author, Dr Lawson has run his own business for 22 years. At two years of age, he was misdiagnosed as intellectually disabled, at school of being incapable of doing as he was told, at 17 years of age he was misdiagnosed with schizophrenia (spending time in and out of mental health institutions). Eventually, at the age of 42, he was diagnosed with an autism spectrum condition (ASC), ADHD, dyspraxia and learning difficulties. Dr Lawson is currently a teaching fellow with Birmingham University's online autism MEd. He is participant and adviser for Autism CRC, Australia, and he has written numerous books and papers on ASC and gender dysphoria.
