Provision map to track progress of children and impact of interventions  
Mentoring programme  
Family Liaison Officer to support families  
Support for attendance of school trips and residential trips  
ELSA (Emotional Literacy Support) has been provided  
Remarkable Children programme  
Rapid Reading

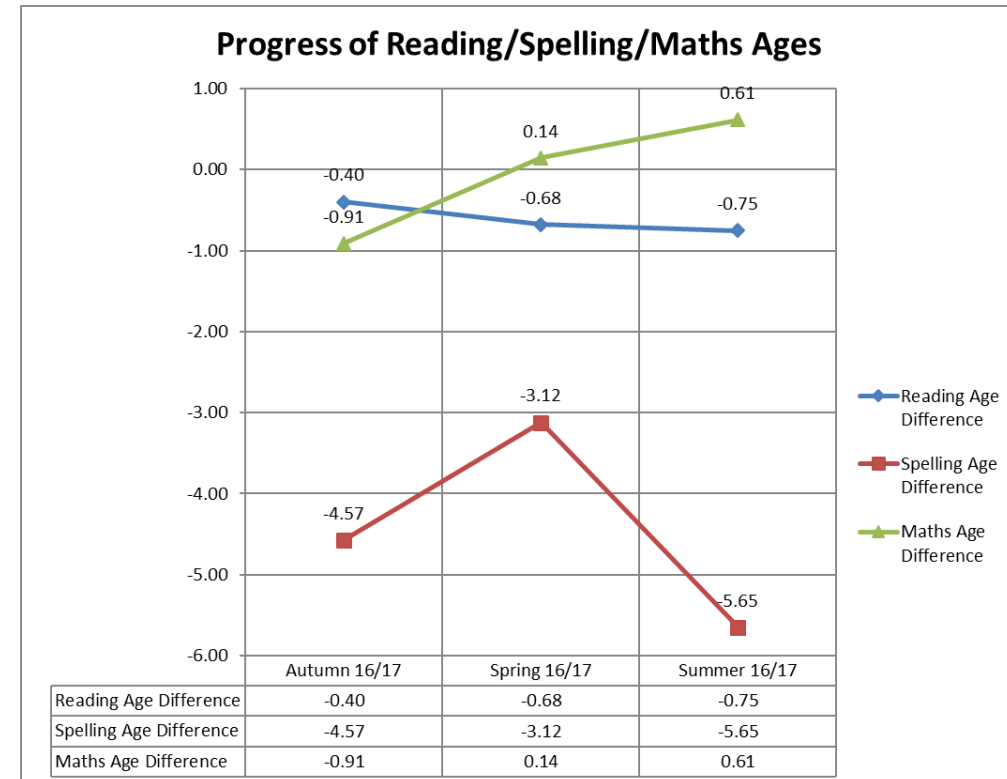
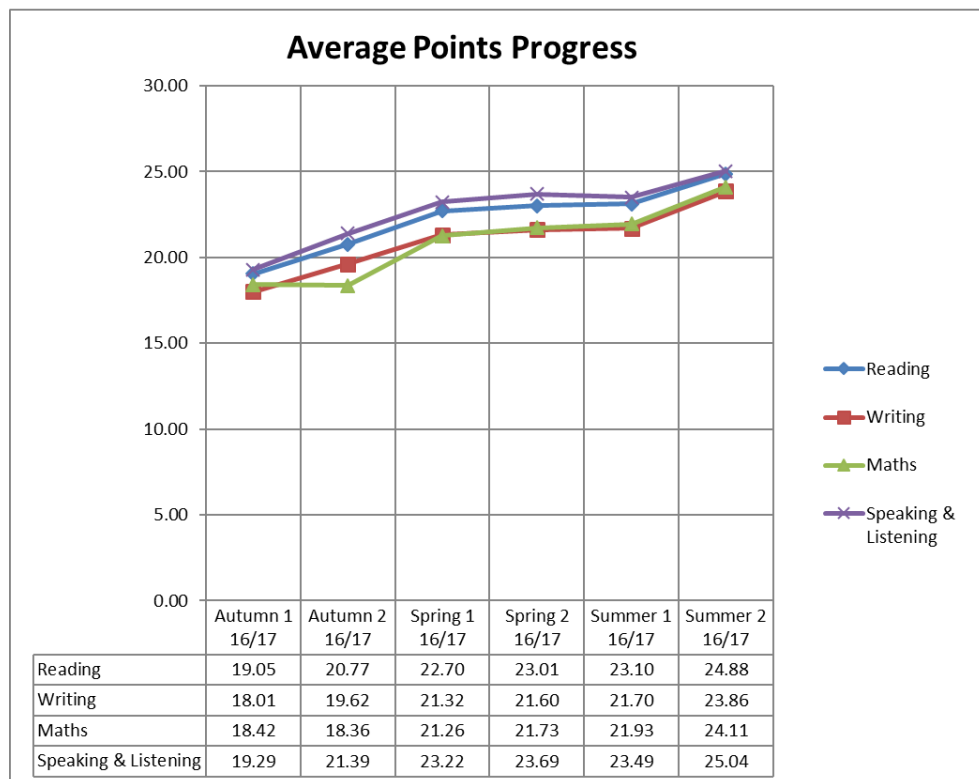
